12.28.010 Alcohol prohibited on public premises.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drink or consume any alcoholic beverage on any public premise without prior consent of the city council.

12.28.020 Alcohol defined.

The term alcoholic beverage, as used in this chapter, shall be construed to mean and include any liquid intended for human consumption containing more than one-half of one percent by volume of alcohol.

12.28.030 Public premises defined.

For the purpose of this ordinance, public premises shall include public streets, sidewalks, alleys, city parks, city buildings and city parking lots under the control and jurisdiction of the city.

12.28.040 Violation--Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a municipal offense. Any person convicted of an offense under this chapter shall be punished by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars.
